Addendum for the PDSW'26 Reproducibility Initiative

Authors of regular papers are **required** to submit an Artifact Description (AD) Appendix that can help to reproduce and validate their experimental results. The inclusion of the Artifact Evaluation (AE) Appendix is optional for PDSW'26 once the paper is accepted. PDSW'26 follows the [SC26 Reproducibility Initiative](#).

Filling out the AD/AE Form

For the Artifact Description (AD) Appendix, please use the [SC26 format](#) for PDSW'26 submissions.

The AD should include a field for one or more links to data (Zenodo, Figshare, etc.) and code (Github, GitLab, Bitbucket, etc.) repositories. For the Artifacts that will be placed in the code repository, we encourage authors to follow the guidelines of SC26 on how to structure the artifact, as this will make it easier for the reviewing committee and readers of the paper in the future.

Applying for AE Badges

Authors of **accepted** papers are **eligible to apply** for up to [three badges](#): Artifact Available, Artifact Evaluated-Functional, and Results Replicated. Instructions on how to submit an application are [here](#). Based on experience, AE reviewers will anonymously contact authors if something doesn't work as expected. All issues have to be resolved by the Artifact freeze date.
